Index of English Literary Manuscripts Produced by an editorial board and advisers, published by Mansell Publishing Ltd, London. 5 vols. This series lists, describes and locates over 40,000 literary texts in manuscript by some 270 major British and Irish authors who flourished between 1450 and 1900. Of the five volumes, some in several parts, due to be completed over the next three years, two have already appeared; Vol. I (1450 to 1625) and Vol. IV (1800-1900), Part 1, A-Ha (1982, 28.5 x 22.5 cm., facsim. illus., casebound, ISBN 0-7201-1587-6, £70.00). Each volume contains a glossary, a survey of the authors' works, letters and miscellanea, analysis of the manuscripts, and notes on new discoveries. Also included are lists of repositories, auction houses, and book-sellers. The final volume will consist of indexes of names, titles, and first lines.
